



To the Families of Walnut Hill,

I am writing now to remind you of a few things that will make your arrival and registration run more smoothly.

- **If your student has ANY medications (prescriptions OR over-the-counter), they must be brought to the health center in order to register.** Please pack medications where they are easily accessible. Even if the student will be keeping their medications with them, they need to be checked by the nurses. No students will be able to register without the health center seeing those medications.
- **Students are not allowed to have prescription or over-the-counter medications in their rooms.** There are a few exceptions for vitamins, emergency medications (EpiPens, inhalers, etc) and birth control pills. Any other medications are kept in the health center for the safety of all students.
- **Please do not bring over-the-counter medications unless they are taken daily or specialized.** The health center supplies over 20 over-the-counter medications that are available to the students as needed. These include: acetaminophen, ibuprofen, antacids, bismuth, decongestants, allergy medications, cough medication, cough drops and more!
- **Please make sure to bring copies of all medical forms if they are not returned to the school already.** There is a \$50.00 charge to have immunizations done in Natick and physicals require off-campus appointments. So, please have this completed prior to a student's arrival or contact the health center if certain paperwork will be arriving late.
- **For international students: Please have your tuberculin test completed BEFORE arriving to campus.** Any international student who does not have this will need to stay off campus until the test is completed.
